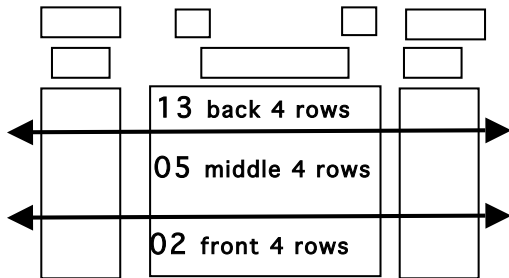

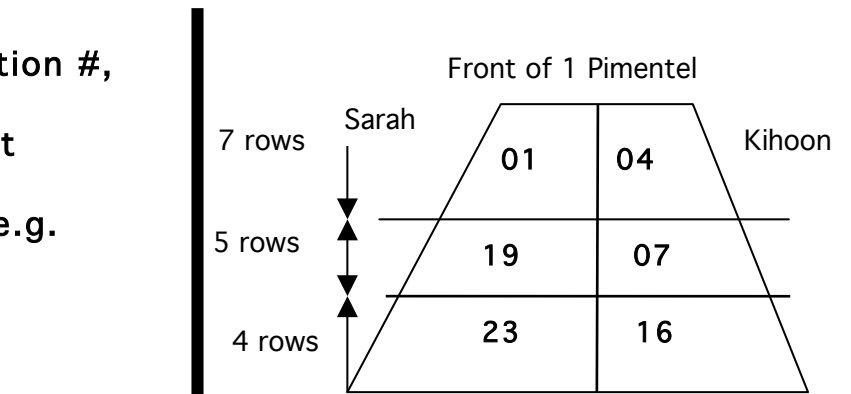

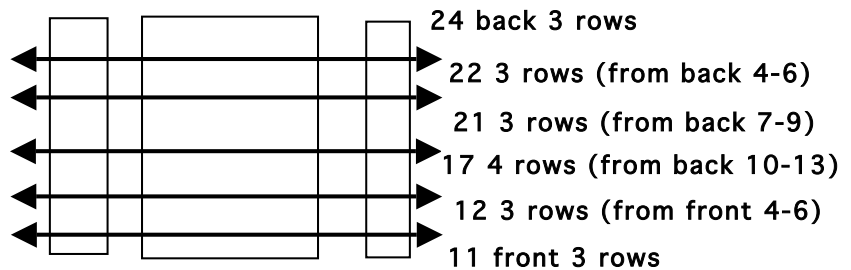
Front 105 Stanley



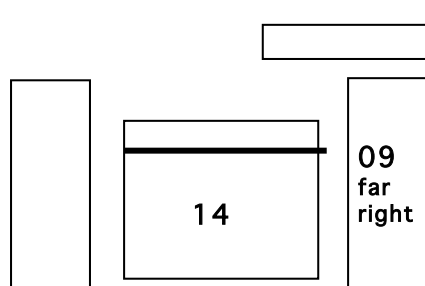
Front 145 Dwinelle



Back of 155 Dwinelle

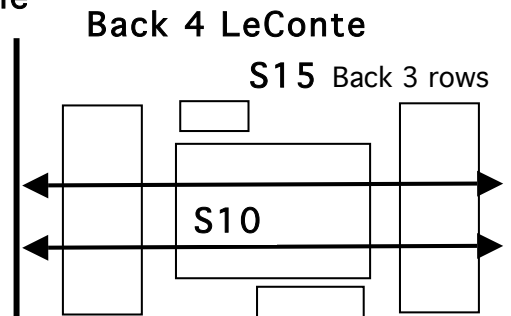


Front of 155 Dwinelle
